- Bear Trax provided a creek bore for Highway 437 due to flooding.
- c. Morgan District has been informed that the grant application was passed by the legislature in this most recent legislative session. Please see attached for the additional requested information.

The only customer account Morgan District has that is listed as a customer acct. is the customer deposit account, which is the basis for the \$30,253.38 that was listed in response to Commission Staff's First Request for Information Item 7b. This account is used for holding customer deposits until such time as they are credited to the customer's account or refunded to the customer if they leave Morgan District's service area.
