On October 21, 2024, the Kentucky Public Service Commission (PSC) accepted for filing Elkhorn Water District's (Elkhorn District) application requesting to increase its revenue from water sales by \$22,830, an approximate increase of 5.58 percent. On March 18, 2025, Commission Staff determined Elkhorn District would require an increase of \$26,954 or 6.59 percent in revenue from water sales. Elkhorn District requests the PSC approve its recommended revenue requirement and that Elkhorn District be allowed to implement the revised rates as follows:

The proposed rates shall not become effective until the Public Service Commission has issued an Order approving these rates. The rates will increase the monthly bill of a typical 5/8 x 3/4 inch customer using 6,680 gallons a month from \$58.00 to \$61.82, an increase of \$3.82, or approximately 6.59 percent. If the Commission does not receive any request for intervention or hearing in this matter within 30 days after the date of publication of this customer notice, the Commission will proceed to render a decision in the matter.
