On October 21. 2024, the Kentucky Public Service Commission (PSC) accepted for filing Elkhorn Water District's (Elkhorn District) application requesting to increase its revenue from water sales by \$22,830, an approximate increase of 5.58 percent. On March 18, 2025, Commission Staff determined Elkhorn District would require an increase of \$26,954 or 6.59 percent in revenue from water sales. Elkhorn District requests the PSC approve its recommended revenue requirement and that Elkhorn District be allowed to implement the revised rates as follows:
