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**JOINT MOTION FOR DECISION ON THE RECORD**

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Comes now North Nelson Water District (“North Nelson District”), and Louisville Water Company (“Louisville Water”) by and through the undersigned counsel, pursuant to the Commission’s October 25, 2024, and December 4, 2024 Orders in the above-referenced proceeding, and for their Joint Motion to Proceed Without a Hearing respectfully state as follows:

On September 26, 2024, Louisville Water filed a Wholesale Water Purchase Agreement with North Nelson District to replace the current Wholesale Water Purchase Agreement between the two parties, and North Nelson District filed a Wholesale Water Purchase Agreement with the city of Bardstown, Kentucky

(“Bardstown”), along with a tariff to establish a new wholesale water rate for Bardstown. The purpose of both agreements and North Nelson District’s proposed tariff is to provide additional water to Bardstown. Under the terms of the agreements, Louisville Water will make additional water available to North Nelson District and North Nelson District will, in turn, provide wholesale water service to Bardstown.

On October 25, 2024, the Commission issued an Order opening this proceeding and suspending Louisville Water’s proposed wholesale water purchase agreement in this matter. By separate Order on October 25, 2024, the Commission opened Case No. 2024-00336<sup>1</sup> and suspended North Nelson District’s tariff establishing a wholesale rate for Bardstown. By Order entered December 4, 2024, the Commission consolidated the record of Case No. 2024-00336 into this proceeding and ordered that all future filings relevant to either Case No. 2024-00335 or Case No. 2024-00336 be filed into the record of this proceeding.

There are **no** intervenors in Case No. 2024-00335 or Case No. 2024-00336. Commission Staff has issued one Request for Information to North Nelson District and one Request for Information to Louisville Water. North Nelson District and Louisville Water have each filed responses to their respective Information Requests.

Additionally, North Nelson District filed the affidavit of Jessica Filliatreau, P.E., the City Civil Engineer for Bardstown into the record of Case No. 2024-00336, and it is incorporated by reference into the record of this proceeding, pursuant to the Commission's December 4, 2024 Order.


Because there are no intervenors in this proceeding, the dates remaining on the Procedural Schedule issued by the Commission in its October 25, 2024 Order are moot except for February 21, 2025, which the Commission established as the last day for North Nelson District or Louisville Water to request either a hearing or that the case be submitted for a decision based on the written record. North Nelson District and Louisville Water each waives its right to a formal hearing in this matter and requests that the Commission proceed without a hearing and decide this case based upon the written record.

Should Commission Staff need additional information, North Nelson District and Louisville Water will promptly respond to any additional Requests for Information and will gladly participate in an informal conference with Staff, should Staff determine that an informal conference would be beneficial. North Nelson District and Louisville Water can appear at such a conference in-person, or participate remotely, whichever is more convenient for Staff.

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, North Nelson District and Louisville Water respectfully and jointly move for a decision on the record in the present case.
