Dear Geenex Power LLC:

The National Park Service (NPS) met with representatives of the Wood Duck Solar Project on June 11, 2025, to discuss concerns raised by Mammoth Cave National Park regarding the proposed solar development in Barren County, Kentucky. As a follow-up to that discussion, the NPS received additional written documentation from Wood Duck Solar on July 23, 2025, which provided detailed responses to the park's questions and concerns.

Based on the information presented during the meeting and the subsequent written materials, the NPS finds that the proposed project includes measures that adequately address the park's concerns, particularly those related to the potential for watershed contamination affecting Mammoth Cave National Park. As a result, Mammoth Cave National Park no longer opposes the Wood Duck Solar Project as currently proposed.
