Ms. Garczyk's has led the development of multiple energy projects in Geenex's portfolio over three years. Prior to her role at Geenex, Ms. Garczyk's experience includes private sector roles in commercial and residential development and as the Planning and Zoning Administrator for a suburban locality outside of Columbus, Ohio. She holds a B.S. in City/Urban, Community, and Regional Planning from The Ohio State University.

Aron Caudill, Director of Land Development and Regenerative Agriculture at Geenex, will be available to discuss the Project's land development and acquisition process, and public outreach

activities related to the Project. Mr. Caudill has over 20 years of experience in land surveying, acquisition, and title examination work related to development of renewable and non-renewable energy generation facilities.

Steve Hazel, Vice President of Interconnection and Engineering at Geenex, will be available to provide testimony regarding site design and engineering, Project interconnection, construction scheduling, and other general matters related to development and construction of the Project. Mr. Hazel's experience includes development, design, and management of more than 100 photovoltaics projects. He holds a B.S. in electrical and computer engineering from Rowan University, is a licensed master electrician, and is certified by the North American Board of Certified Energy Practitioners.

Chad Martin, Senior Principal at Stantec, will be available to provide testimony regarding the Project's layout, glare, noise generation from construction and operation, environmental surveys, decommissioning, traffic impacts, and other site-specific issues. Mr. Martin is a Professional Wetland Scientist and Certified Wildlife Biologist, with expertise including NEPA documentation, wildlife hazard assessments, construction monitoring, and post-construction biological field studies.

Richard C. Kirkland Sr., of Kirkland Appraisals, LLC, will be available to provide testimony regarding the impact of the Project on the value of adjoining properties. Mr. Kirkland has worked as a commercial property appraiser since 1996 and has specific experience in analyzing property value impacts related to development of merchant electric generating facilities in Kentucky.

Dr. Paul Coomes will be available to provide testimony regarding the economic impact the Project will have at both regional and state levels. As an Emeritus Professor of Economics at the

University of Louisville, Dr. Coomes holds a Ph.D. in Economics from the University of Texas at Austin. Dr. Coomes also has specific experience in analyzing the regional and state economic impacts related to the development of merchant electric generating facilities in Kentucky.
