## DATA REQUEST

**KPSC 2\_1** Provide a list of the thermal violations related to the risers at the Bellefonte Station for calendar years 2019 through 2024.

### **RESPONSE**

There have been no thermal violations identified on the risers at the Bellefonte Station for the years 2019 through 2024 as defined by AEP and PJM's planning criteria. The planning criteria defined violations are based on expected conditions in 2026. The Proposed Project would prevent these thermal violations from occurring in the future.

## DATA REQUEST

**KPSC 2\_2** Confirm that the Kentucky Power costs of this project will be allocated to AEP companies through PJM Interconnection, LLC. If not confirmed, explain.

### **RESPONSE**

Confirmed in part. The allocation of the costs of this Project is a multistep process, which includes an initial allocation by PJM under the Open Access Transmission Tariff ("OATT") to the AEP East zone, and then a reallocation under the AEP East Transmission Agreement to each operating company that is a party to that agreement. The Project will be included in the total OATT Expense that is paid collectively by all the wholesale transmission customers of the PJM transmission system. PJM then allocates the total PJM OATT expense among the transmission zones, including the AEP East zone, based on cost allocation rules included in the PJM OATT. Then, PJM allocates the zonal costs to each load serving entity ("LSE") within the AEP East zone, including Kentucky Power and the other AEP East operating companies, based on each LSE's contribution to the single highest hourly peak of the zone in a 12-month period, or in other words, on a 1-coincident peak ("CP") basis. The total AEP East Operating Company zonal cost is then reallocated under the AEP East Transmission Agreement to each operating company that is a party to that agreement, including Kentucky Power, on a 12-CP basis.

**KPSC 2\_3** Refer to Case No. 2024-00017 as discussed at the informal conference held on December 17, 2024. Provide the remaining amount of approved indebtedness not yet utilized by Kentucky Power.

#### **RESPONSE**

As of December 31, 2024, the Company had \$150 million remaining on its approved long-term debt authority. On January 2, 2025, the Company issued a \$150 million term loan to repay some of its elevated short-term debt balance used to fund the Company's operations until its pending securitization bonds are issued. The Company anticipates filing for additional long-term debt authority in the near future.

#### DATA REQUEST

**KPSC 2\_4** Provide the number of customers, by customer class, affected by any outages at the Bellefonte Station.

#### **RESPONSE**

There have not been any outages caused by equipment located at Bellefonte Station over the past five years (see the Company's response to KPSC 1-15). Therefore, no customers have been impacted by outages at Bellefonte from 2019 to 2024.

Nonetheless, the main driver for the Project is baseline planning needs (i.e. to prevent thermal violations from occurring in the future). The supplemental components of the proposed Project are proposed to be done at the same time, in part, to maximize efficiency of construction resources and planned outages necessary. In addition, the supplemental work also will address assets that are becoming increasingly expensive to maintain, and which would also be more expensive to replace if they were to fail rather than as a proactive replacement based on their age, condition, and risk as proposed now. See Koehler Testimony Page 3 Lines 6-19 for a summary of the need for the supplemental work.

Please see the below table for outages and associated customer impacts on associated facilities (circuits) served out of Bellefonte Station from 2019 to 2024. Any outages that were initially provided in response to KPSC 1-15 but that did not have direct impact on Kentucky customers were omitted from the below table. CI refers to the total number of customers interrupted because of the subject outage, either directly served by Transmission (T) or served by Distribution (D).
