1. The City of Livingston opened the bid from Kentucky American Water in August 2025.

However, there has not been a change of management or ownership yet.

(a) There was only one bid received.

(b) The City of Livingston has entered into an agreement with Kentucky
American Water for the sale of the utility. (Exhibit 1)

2. The current balance owed to Wood Creek Water District as of October 2025 is
\$53,920.55.
3. The status of payment is unknown currently. All documentation for debt relief has been
submitted, and the City of Livingston is awaiting payment by KIA. KIA has notified the
City of Livingston that the debt will be paid in full.
4. There are no executed agreements regarding payment outside of PSC findings. In
December of 2024, an agreement was made for Livingston Municipal Water Works to sell
the system.

5. All payments have been made promptly over the last six months to my knowledge. Most payments have been hand-delivered by the 15th of each month.
