**REPLY IN SUPPORT OF MOTION FOR CONFIDENTIAL TREATMENT
AND NOTICE FOR FILING**

Comes now East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. (“EKPC”), by and through counsel, pursuant to KRS 61.878, 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13 and other applicable law, and for its reply in support of its motion requesting that the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) afford confidential treatment to certain information filed as supplemental responses to Appalachian Citizens Law Center, Kentuckians for the Commonwealth, Kentucky Solar Energy Society, and the Mountain Association’s (collectively “Joint Intervenors”) Second Request for Information (“Joint Intervenors’ Second Request”) states as follows:

On May 22, 2025, the Joint Intervenors filed a response to EKPC’s Motion for Confidential Treatment regarding the Reaction Engineering International’s EKPC Spurlock 3 Co-Fire Project Final Report (“REI Report”) which was filed under seal on May 19, 2025. In that response, the Joint Intervenors stated “EKPC has not explained why it could not simply redact the portions of


the Report pertaining to negotiating strategy.” After reviewing the response and that statement by the Joint Intervenors, EKPC has discussed with its environmental counsel, and believes that it can produce a redacted confidential version of the REI Report to the parties in this proceeding, consistent with the Joint Intervenors’ response. However, due to the holiday weekend and persons required to review and redact the REI Report being out of the office, the redacted confidential version cannot be provided until Tuesday, May 27, 2025.

EKPC believes that this will allow the Joint Intervenors to share the information from the REI Report that is relevant to the feasibility of co-firing Spurlock Unit 3 and 4 with their experts and counsel that are located out of state, while allowing EKPC to redact the information related to strategy and information for the negotiations over the Kentucky implementation of the GHG Rule. This will also still allow the opportunity to review the entirety of the REI Report at the Commission’s office, at EKPC’s headquarters or at EKPC’s regulatory counsel’s office.

Therefore, EKPC gives notice of its intent to file a confidential, redacted version of the REI Report and to provide the redacted version of the REI Report, which will still be filed under seal, pursuant to the Motion for Confidential Treatment previously filed and will still be subject to the Confidentiality Agreement signed by the parties.


