

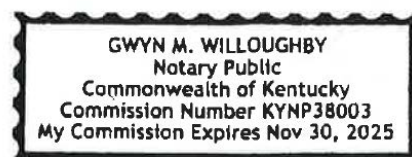

Request 2. Please refer to HVT April 21 at 10:22:25 to 10:24:50 and 11:36:45 to 11:49:20 and provide any contracts, commitment letters, and other documentation of EKPC's commitment with Siemens regarding the proposed Cooper combined cycle gas turbine (CCGT).

Response 2. EKPC's contract with Siemens contains a confidentiality clause. EKPC cannot provide the contract without Siemens' written consent. EKPC requested written consent from the Siemens for EKPC to provide the contract under seal in this proceeding. However, at the time of filing this response, EKPC has not received permission from Siemens to provide the contract. EKPC will continue attempting to obtain permission to file the contracts and will supplement this response if such permission is obtained.

May 9, 2025 Update.

EKPC is providing the contract with Siemens under seal. Pursuant to Clause 5 of the Reservation Agreement, Siemens has granted the required written permission to disclose the contract to the Commission and parties who have executed a confidentiality agreement for these proceedings,

however; Siemens has not provided permission for the contract to be publicly disclosed. If the Commission declines confidential treatment of the Reservation Agreement, Siemens will withdraw the permission to disclose any portion of the contract to any party.

Additionally, the version of the contract filed under seal contains redactions. EKPC has a reservation for an additional unit. EKPC has not exercised any portion. If, or when, EKPC determines the additional unit will be necessary the appropriate request for a Certificate for Public Convenience and Necessity will be filed with the Commission.
