- 3. At this time, Owensboro Solar no long intends to file an application for a Certificate to Construct a merchant solar electric generating facility and is requesting the Siting Board allow

this matter to be closed and removed from the Siting Board's docket. If in the future, Owensboro Solar believes it will file an application it will request a new docket to file an application.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, Owensboro Solar respectfully requests the Siting Board permit this matter to be closed and removed from the Siting Board's docket.
