If the Public Service Commission approves the proposed water rates, then the monthly water bill for a customer with a 5/8 by 3/4 inch meter using an average of 3,432 gallons per month will increase from \$46.48 to \$52.22 for an increase of \$5.74 or 12.36%.

If the Public Service Commission approves the proposed water rates, then the monthly water bill for a customer with a 1 inch meter using an average of 37,510 gallons per month will increase from \$402.71 to \$452.46 for an increase of \$49.76 or 12.36%

If the Public Service Commission approves the proposed water rates, then the monthly water bill for a customer with a 1 1/2 inch meter using an average of 15,860 gallons per month will increase from \$183.27 to \$205.91 for an increase of \$22.64 or 12.36%.

If the Public Service Commission approves the proposed water rates, then the monthly water bill for a customer with a 2 inch meter using an average of 113,592 gallons per month will increase from \$1,112.27 to \$1,260.93 for an increase of \$138.57 or 12.36%.

There are currently no customers with a 3 inch meter.

If the Public Service Commission approves the proposed water rates, then the monthly water bill for a customer with a 4 inch meter using an average of 190,177 gallons per month will increase from \$1,838.36 to \$2,065.40 for an increase of \$227.14 or 12.36%.

If the Public Service Commission a approved the proposed water rates, then wholesale customers using an average of 100 data.
