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**STATEMENT REGARDING HEARING PROCEDURE**

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Lost City Renewables LLC, by counsel, hereby provides the following statement regarding hearing procedures.

Lost City appreciates the Siting Board’s agreement to allow Richard Kirkland to appear virtually for the hearing. Given the fact that he will be in Germany, which is six hours ahead of Eastern Daylight Time, Lost City anticipates that it will present Mr. Kirkland first in the order of witnesses. In addition, it may request that Mr. Kirkland be permitted to testify at the outset of the hearing so that he may have a time certain to appear, particularly if there appears to be several members of the public providing oral comments.

Following Mr. Kirkland’s testimony and public comment, Lost City anticipates calling the witnesses listed in its witness list in the following order: Paul Coomes, Sean Joshi, Shane Kelley, and Marty Marcheterre. Lost City does not anticipate any other witnesses to be called for any party, as no other party identified any witnesses to be called at the hearing prior to the mandatory deadline of June 6, 2025, set by 807 KAR 5:110, Section 6(2) and (3).<sup>1</sup>

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<sup>1</sup> The Intervenor filed a subpoena form on June 9, 2025, which was after the witness list deadline. It does not appear that the Siting Board has issued a subpoena, nor does it appear that the Siting Board has statutory authority to issue a subpoena.

Lost City further notes its objection if any Intervenor attempt to provide public comments. In the April 1, 2025, Order, the Siting Board noted that the Intervenor “would not unduly complicate the proceeding.”<sup>2</sup> Further, it specifically stated: “The Siting Board reminds all Movants [now Intervenor] that counsel represents them in this matter, and they should speak and participate in this matter through their attorney.” At least half of the individual Intervenor have violated the Siting Board’s Order by filing written public comments after the Siting Board’s Order was issued, requiring them to work through their attorney. The Intervenor should not be permitted to violate the Siting Board’s Order.
