Lost City Renewables LLC ("Lost City") hereby submits for filing this Notice of Intent to file an application for a Certificate of Construction for an approximately 250 MW solar facility ("Lost City Project").

b. The proposed construction is briefly described as follows:

The facility will consist in approximately 1,425 acres of solar panels and associated racking (approximately 250 MW), inverters, electric equipment, project substation and transformer, utility switching station, and underground electrical connection lines.



- c. The proposed Lost City Project will be located approximately 0.4 miles east of Penrod and 1.25 miles northeast of Dunmor. It will be east of Ky Hwy 431 and primarily south of Ky Hwy 949. The latitude and longitude are 37°06'15.45"N, 86°58'48.535"W. The Lost City Project is not located within the limits of any city. It will be located in Muhlenberg County.
- d. The Muhlenberg Joint City/County Planning Commission with an address of 214 North 1st Street, Central City, KY 42330 has jurisdiction over this site.
- e. There are no setback requirements established by the planning and zoning commission.
- f. There are no residential neighborhoods, schools, hospitals, or nursing home facilities within 2,000 feet of the project. Accordingly, the applicant will not request a deviation from the setback requirements found in KRS 278.704(2).
