**Q 1-1. State if the training scheduled for February 19, 2025, has occurred.**

A 1-1. No. The training scheduled to occur in Bowling Green, Kentucky on February 19, 2025, has not yet occurred. The training was postponed due to the heavy flooding that devastated parts of Kentucky during the weekend of February 15 and 16, 2025, and the winter storm that was predicted to impact western Kentucky, including the city of Bowling Green, on February 18, 2025. The leadership team at KRWA made the difficult decision to postpone its 2025 Management Conference, which was scheduled for February 19 and 20, 2025. Conference attendees were planning to travel from all regions of the state to attend the Management Conference and given the devastating flooding in Pikeville and other areas, along with the hazards associated with travel in possible blizzard conditions, KRWA decide to err on the side of caution and postpone its annual Management Conference. Attached to

this response as **Attachment 1-1a**. Is the email sent to those who had registered for the event.

KRWA has **rescheduled** the 2025 Management Conference for **November 5 and 6, 2025** in the same location. Attached to this response as **Attachment 1-1b** is the email announcement that was sent to those who had previously registered for the event. KRWA has confirmed the availability of all individuals who were scheduled to speak at the conference. All presentations that were conditionally approved by the Commission in its February 5, 2025 Order in this proceeding will be included in the 2025 Management Conference agenda for the event scheduled to be held on November 5 and 6, 2025, in Bowling Green, Kentucky. There will be no change in the program content, only a change in the date it will be presented.
