# MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF WATER COMMISSIONERS OF NORTH MCLEAN COUNTY WATER DISTRICT HELD MARCH 20, 2023 AT 7:00 P.M. AT THE DISTRICT OFFICE 217 HILL STREET LIVERMORE, KY 42352

The regular meeting of the North McLean County Board of Water Commissioners was held March 20, 2023 at 7:00 P.M., at the District Office in Livermore, Kentucky.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Keith Ayer, who presided over the meeting.

The minutes of the regular meeting on February 20, 2023 were read. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Commissioner Dale Chandler and seconded by Commissioner Wayne Bell. A vote was taken and motion passed.

Evan Stinnett, a water customer who resides at 318 Pleasant Hill Church Road, Calhoun, KY 42327 is in need of a waterline extension behind Pleasant Hope Church Road. The area where Mr. Stinnett's waterline currently is located, a lake will be installed. The total footage will be 200 ft. A motion was made by Commissioner Dale Chandler and seconded by Commissioner Gary Floyd to extend waterline behind Pleasant Hope Church Road agreeing that North McLean County Water District to pay for the first 100 ft and Evan Stinnett pay the next 100 ft at \$100 an

North McLean County Water District Secretary, Tiffany Sallee presented the board the cost of setting a residential meter (5/8" x 3/8") and a one-inch water meter. A motion was made by Commissioner Dale Chandler and seconded by Commissioner Gary Floyd to file the paperwork with the Kentucky Public Service Commission to increase the service connection for a 5/8 x 3/8 water meter from \$660.50 to \$997.49 and to increase a one-inch water meter from \$828.54 to \$1,475.44, any larger water meter set at actual cost. Motion carried unanimously.

Chairman Keith Ayer presented to the board quotes on trailers to haul the new excavator. A motion was made by Commissioner Dale Chandler and seconded by Commissioner Wayne Bell to purchase a trailer from Miles Trailer Sales, Beechmont, KY with a purchase price of \$7,300.

Chairman Keith Ayer informed the Board of Commissioners that Kentucky 811 includes a ticket management system free of charge that will allow the maintenance to mark the status of a locate. A motion was made by Commissioner Dale Chandler and seconded by Commissioner Wayne Bell to rescind the motion made on February 20, 2023 the board no longer accepts the KorTerra program, the district refuses this program as the ticket system allows the maintenance do the same job with no cost to the district.

The Masonic Temple Association updated North McLean County Water District's lease agreement. The agreement commences on May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023 and terminates April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2028. A motion by Commissioner Wayne Bell and seconded by Commissioner Dale Chandler to accept the lease agreement. Lease agreement attached to minutes.

Chairman Keith Ayer presented the Independence Bank open line of credit is due to renew. The line of credit is \$175,000. The line of credit is open from dates of use from March 16, 2023 to March 16, 2024. A motion was made by Commissioner Gary Floyd and seconded by Commissioner Wayne Bell to renew the \$175,000 line of credit with Independence Bank.

Chairman Keith Ayer has a one-inch water meter at his farm on HWY 250. Mr. Ayer would like to have a two-inch water meter. The water meter is on a six-inch water line and 80 pounds of pressure at meter. A motion was made by Commissioner Dale Chandler and seconded by Commissioner Wayne Bell to approve a two-inch water meter for Keith Ayer. Motion passed with Chairman Keith Ayer abstaining.

Chairman Keith Ayer informed the board that Daviess County Water District's water purchased rates will decrease from \$4.84 to \$4.17 per 1,000 gallons starting March 31, 2023 billing.

The bills payable were read, approved and ordered paid upon a motion made by Commissioner Gary Floyd and seconded by Commissioner Wayne Bell. Motion passed with an unanimous

There being no further discussion, upon motion duly made by Commissioner Dale Chandler seconded by Commissioner Wayne Bell and passed without opposition, the meeting adjourned at 8:06 P.M.
