MOTION TO RECOVER COSTS

Comes now East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. ("EKPC"), by and through counsel, pursuant to KRS 278.183 and other applicable law, and requests authorization to recover \$561,263 of under recovery that was identified in Commission Staff's Third Request for Information ("Staff's Third Request") and, respectfully states as follows:

1. On March 5, 2025, the Commission opened a proceeding pursuant to KRS 278.183(3) to examine EKPC's environmental surcharge mechanism for the six-month periods ending May 31, 2022, November 30, 2022, November 30, 2023, May 31, 2024, and November 30, 2024, and the two year period ending May 31, 2023.

2. Throughout the proceeding, Commission Staff issued requests for information regarding the expenses being recovered by the environmental surcharge. In Staff's Third Request, Item 2, Commission Staff requested a reconciliation for ES Form 2.5 and ES Form 2.4 for February

 $2021.^{1}$ In preforming the requested reconciliation of ES Form. 2.5 and ES Form 2.4, it was discovered that EKPC has under recovered \$561,263.²

3. KRS 278.183(1) states that a utility shall be entitled to the recover of costs of complying with federal environmental regulations.³ KRS 278.183(3) allows the commission to disallow surcharge amounts that are not just and reasonable.⁴

4. The Commission reviewed EKPC's environmental surcharge and found that EKPC has prudently incurred costs related to all projects within its compliance plan.⁵ EKPC is now requesting the Commission allow it to recover the under recovery \$561,263 that was found through the discovery process in this case.
