KENTUCKY FRONTIER GAS, LLC’S MOTION FOR DECISION

Comes now Kentucky Frontier Gas, LLC (“Kentucky Frontier”), by counsel, and for its motion for decision, respectfully states as follows:

Kentucky Frontier filed its application seeking a declaratory order on whether certain customers were entitled to free gas on February 19, 2025.¹ Kentucky Frontier responded to data requests from Commission staff on November 26, 2025.² On January 27, 2026, Coty Brown, Lindsey Brown, Linda Sue Brown Allen, Ryan Allen, Kathy Howard, Ricki Carty, and Crystal Shawn Risner (“Intervenors”) were granted intervention.³ After motion practice, the Intervenors responded to data requests from Staff and Kentucky Frontier on March 25, 2026.⁴ Kentucky Frontier filed its rebuttal on April 9, 2026.⁵ On April 16, 2026, Kentucky Frontier tendered its brief and submitted this matter for a decision.⁶ On April 16, 2026, the Intervenors filed a response to Kentucky Frontier’s Request to Submit on the Record.⁷ The Response did not request a hearing

on this matter but rather simply requested that Kentucky Frontier’s “request for a declaratory ruling and for submission of this matter on the record” be denied.⁸ Kentucky Frontier moved to strike the Intervenor’s Response or alternatively for the matter to stand submitted on the record.⁹

Despite having the right to enter the property by virtue of Kentucky Frontier’s easements on the property, some of the Intervenor’s are refusing to allow Kentucky Frontier to access their properties because they maintain they have a right to free gas. In order to continue to provide safe and reliable service to its customers, Kentucky Frontier needs to be able to get these properties to perform work on the gas lines before the winter months. Therefore, Kentucky Frontier respectfully requests the Commission enter an order on its application seeking a declaratory order on whether certain customers were entitled to free gas no later than August 15, 2026.
