MOTION OF JOINT INTERVENORS KENTUCKIANS FOR THE COMMONWEALTH, KENTUCKY SOLAR ENERGY SOCIETY, METROPOLITAN HOUSING COALITION, AND MOUNTAIN ASSOCIATION FOR LEAVE TO DEVIATE FROM RULE

Come now Kentuckians for the Commonwealth, Kentucky Solar Energy Society, Metropolitan Housing Coalition, and Mountain Association (collectively "Joint Intervenors"), by and through counsel, and move for leave to deviate from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:001 Section 8. In support of their motion Joint Intervenors state as follows:

- 1. 807 KAR 5:001 Section 8(3) requires filings be made with the Commission via the Commission's E-Filing System at http://psc.ky.gov. 807 KAR 5:001 Section 8(4) requires electronic filings be made in one of several set formats. 807 KAR 5:001 Section 8(6) sets limits on the size of electronic filings. 807 KAR 5:001 Section 22 allows deviation from the rules in special cases upon good cause shown.
- 2. The Joint Intervenors timely filed their Responses to Kentucky Utilities
 Company and Louisville Gas and Electric Company's Joint Data Requests on July 03,
 2025. Included with the response were a number of workpapers in Excel format, in
 compliance with 807 KAR 5:001 Section 8(4)(c). However, one of the workpapers of

Joint Intervenor witness Eiden in Excel format exceeded the size limitation of 807 KAR 5:001 Section 8(6), and the Commission's E-Filing System. A copy of that workpaper was provided via link to psced@ky.gov, and counsel for the Companies. At the request of Commission staff a thumb drive version is also being sent via US mail.

3. The electronic version shared with staff and Counsel for the Companies was received by counsel, and uploaded to the Companies' file sharing site the same day as the filing, so no parties have been prejudiced by the alternative means of filing.

Wherefore, Joint Intervenors respectfully request the Commission grant the leave requested, and grant leave to deviate from the rule requiring all filings be made via the Commission's E-Filing System.
