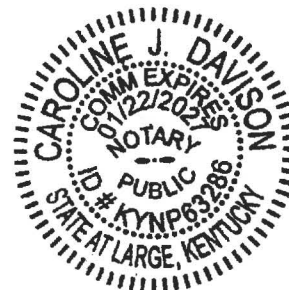

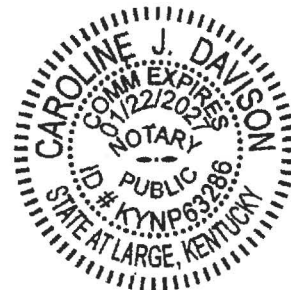

A-47. **Original Response:**

The Companies assume this question should refer to KCA 1-4. The Companies are addressing the possibility of delaying the retirement of Mill Creek 2 in the context of a broader analysis to determine the optimal approach for supporting economic development and managing tariff, ITC, firm gas transport availability, and load risk for customers.
