Q-18. Explain whether LG&E/KU has any other production slots with General Electric (GE) or any other NGCC manufacturer regardless of whether it relates to this application or not. As part of the response, provide the number of slots as well as manufacturers.

A-18. **Original Response:**

The Companies do not yet have other production slots with GE or any other NGCC manufacturers but assess a high probability that market conditions will require an additional production slot in the near future. The Companies currently have one production slot with GE.

September 8, 2025 Supplemental Response:

As indicated in the Companies' original response, the continued fluidity of market demand for gas turbines made a Reservation Agreement (RA) for Mill Creen 6 ("MC6") highly probable to support a June 2031 COD. As a result of market activity since that submission, the Companies entered into an RA with GE Vernova on August 27 for MC6. The Companies now have two production slots with GE. A copy of the RA is being provided in a separate file. The information provided is confidential and proprietary and is being provided under seal pursuant to a petition for confidential protection.
