**EAST KENTUCKY POWER COOPERATIVE, INC.’S
MOTION AN EXTENSION OF TIME**

Comes now East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. (“EKPC”), by counsel, pursuant to KRS 278.183 and 807 KAR 5:001, and respectfully requests the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) grant an extension of time to provide responses to Commission Staff’s Second Rehearing Request for Information. In support of this motion, EKPC respectfully states as follows:

1. On January 26, 2026, the Commission issued an Order granting rehearing related to its findings regarding Project 44 of EKPC’s Environmental Compliance Plan.¹ Commission Staff then issued requests for information on the issue.² EKPC has responded to one request for information³ and its subsequent responses are due on March 27, 2026.



2. Based upon the requests for information, EKPC has requested an Informal Conference with Commission Staff.⁴ EKPC believes information discussed at the potential Informal Conference will provide more clarity for its responses. Therefore, EKPC is requesting an extension to file its responses to Commission Staff's Second Rehearing Request for Information until after the Commission rules on the request for an Informal Conference.

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, EKPC respectfully requests the Commission allow an extension for it to file its responses to Commission Staff's Second Request for Information after the Commission issues a ruling on the request for an Informal Conference.
