Water Management Services, LLC completed the review of the bids submitted for the GCWD Tank Renovations Project. The bidding document included additive alternate bid items that allow for the selection of tanks that will be renovated as part of the project. Based on the conditions of the storage tanks and the availability of funding it is recommended that the project be awarded based on the total price for the base bid plus Alternate Bid Item No. 2 and 3.

Based on the selection of these alternatives the review finds that G&L Tank Sandblasting & Coating, LLC. is the lowest bidder for the project with a total bid of \$988,300.00. based on the review of references and past performance of this firm, we find that G&L Tank Sandblasting & Coating, LLC has satisfactory "Track Record" of completed work on projects similar to this project.
