NOTICE OF INTENT TO PLACE RATES INTO
EFFECT PURSANT TO KRS 278.190(2)

Comes now Farmers Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation (“Farmers”), by counsel, and does hereby provide its notice pursuant to KRS 278.190(2) and the Commission’s May 13, 2025 Order suspending Farmers’ proposed rates until November 4, 2025. Farmers respectfully states as follows:

1. On May 5, 2025, Farmers filed an application requesting an adjustment of rates. On May 13, 2025, the Commission entered an order that suspended the effective date of Farmers’ proposed rate increase and tariffs for five months, up to and including November 4, 2025. On July 23, 2025, the Commission entered an order setting a Formal Hearing in this matter on September 18, 2025.

2. Pursuant to KRS 278.190(2), this proceeding has not concluded nor an order made to date, therefore, Farmers hereby gives notice that it will be putting proposed rates into effect for bills rendered on, or after, January 1, 2025, to align with Farmers’ billing cycle. Farmers will maintain its records in a manner as will enable it, its customers, or the Commission to determine the amounts to be refunded in the event a refund is awarded.

WHEREFORE, Farmers respectfully provides notice pursuant to KRS 278.190(2) that it will place rates into effect for bills rendered on, or after, January 1, 2026.
