**REHEARING BRIEF OF
KENTUCKY INDUSTRIAL UTILITY CUSTOMERS, INC.**

On March 11, 2026, Kentucky Utilities Company and Louisville Gas & Electric Company (collectively “KU/LG&E or “Companies”) filed a Joint Petition for Reconsideration of the Kentucky Public Service Commission’s (“Commission”) February 16, 2026 Orders (“Petition”) in the above-captioned matters. On March 18, 2026, Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc. (“KIUC”) and other parties filed detailed Responses to that Petition. On March 27, 2026, the Commission granted the Companies’ Petition, allowing for two additional rounds of discovery on the issues identified for rehearing. On June 8, 2026, the Commission issued an Order allowing the parties to file simultaneous briefs in support of their respective rehearing positions.

After reviewing the rehearing data responses, KIUC’s position remains the same as that reflected in its March 27, 2026 Response to the Petition. Specifically, KIUC continues to support the Companies’ primary request that the Stipulation be approved as filed. But if the Commission approves the Stipulation’s Sharing Mechanism on rehearing, that approval should be contingent upon the Companies once again agreeing to a 2.5-year base rate case stay-out (new base rates cannot be effective until August 1, 2028). The Sharing Mechanism was the fundamental quid

pro quo for the base rate case stay-out negotiated within the Stipulation. Consequently, the Commission should not approve one without requiring the other.
