KENTUCKY BROADBAND AND CABLE ASSOCIATION’S
MOTION REGARDING WITNESS AVAILABILITY

The Kentucky Broadband and Cable Association and its members¹ (“KBCA”), by counsel, respectfully moves the Public Service Commission for an Order concerning the availability of KBCA witness Patricia Kravtin at the evidentiary hearing scheduled to commence on Monday, November 3, 2025. Specifically, KBCA seeks Commission authorization to have Kravtin appear to testify on or after Tuesday, November 4, 2025. This would enable Kravtin to travel from out of state to Frankfort on the first day of the hearing.

KBCA believes that this request will not be disruptive or impose burdens on the Commission or any party, given the anticipated process for the hearing. At the outset of the hearing, the Commission will receive public comment after which Kentucky Utilities Company and Louisville Gas & Electric Company (the “Companies”) have indicated that they will present 21 witnesses for potential cross-examination. Although the order of intervening parties presenting witnesses has not yet been determined, it is extremely unlikely that public comments and the Companies’ witnesses could conclude on the first day of the hearing with sufficient time to call intervenors’ witnesses to testify.

Accordingly, KBCA respectfully requests authorization for Patricia Kravtin to be excused from appearing to testify on the first day of the hearing.
