
**KENTUCKY UTILITIES COMPANY’S
AND LOUISVILLE GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY’S
STATEMENT REGARDING HEARING AND MOTION FOR BRIEFING DEADLINE**

The Commission’s March 27, 2026 Order granted Kentucky Utilities Company’s (“KU”) and Louisville Gas and Electric Company’s (“LG&E”) (collectively, the “Companies”) Petition for Reconsideration and set a procedural schedule for the reconsideration process. Discovery has occurred and the only remaining deadline in the procedural schedule is the May 26, 2026 deadline by which the parties are to either request a hearing or request that the matter be submitted on the written record. The Companies do not request a hearing because there do not appear to be contested issues of material fact that have arisen during the rehearing process that require a hearing to address; rather, the issues to be decided are legal and can be addressed through briefs. Therefore, the Companies request the matter be submitted on the written record after the parties are provided an opportunity to submit one round of briefs on the issues presented on reconsideration.

Regarding the schedule for briefing, absent approval of the Sharing Mechanism set forth in the Stipulation, the Companies will need to initiate new rate cases in the near term, likely before the end of the year, to support significant ongoing capital investments necessary to serve customers. This reality makes the timing of an Order on rehearing critical. The Companies therefore respectfully request that the Commission issue its Orders by August 14, 2026. To allow adequate time for the Commission's consideration of rehearing briefs, the Companies further move the Commission to establish June 19, 2026, as the deadline for the submission of briefs addressing the issues on rehearing, with the cases then submitted for a decision on the written record as of 11:59 p.m. on that date.


