**KENTUCKY-AMERICAN WATER COMPANY, INC.’S**  
**MOTION TO ALLOW WITNESS MICHAEL ADAMS**  
**TO ATTEND HEARING REMOTELY**

Kentucky-American Water Company, Inc. (“KAWC” or “Company”), hereby moves the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) to allow its external witness Michael Adams to appear and testify remotely at the September 23, 2025 hearing in this matter. As grounds for this motion, KAW respectfully states that Mr. Adams has a professional scheduling conflict that would work an undue hardship on Mr. Adams if he must travel to Kentucky for the hearing. Mr. Adams provided direct testimony in this case on May 16, 2025, and he is a sponsoring witness on only five data responses. KAW does not anticipate that Mr. Adams will be filing rebuttal testimony. Counsel for the Attorney General and Lexington-Fayette County Government have authorized KAWC to represent that they do not have an objection to this motion.

WHEREFORE, KAWC respectfully requests that Mr. Adams be allowed to appear and testify remotely at the September 23, 2025 hearing in this matter.


