1. Refer to Kentucky-American’s response to Commission Staff’s Post-Hearing Requests, Item 8. Provide the Missouri rate structure and rates for the period of time used to sample usage data for the cost of service study

Response:

As stated in the Company’s response to PSCHDR_NUM008, the period of time used to sample usage data for the cost of service study was January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024. The sample usage data included residential, commercial, and Other Public Authority (“OPA”) meters.

The Missouri-American Water Company serves general service residential, commercial, and OPA metered customers on its Rate A. The rate structure of Rate A is as follows. There is a Minimum Customer Charge that is differentiated by meter size. In addition to the Minimum Customer Charge, there is a Commodity Charge for all water used registered by the meter. The Commodity Charge is different for St Louis County Service Area customers and All Missouri Service Areas Outside of St. Louis County. In addition to the Rate A rates, there is a Water & Sewer Infrastructure Replacement Surcharge (“WSIRA”) that applies to the residential, commercial, and OPA classes as they benefit from projects eligible for WSIRA recovery.

The Minimum Customer Charges for all Rate A customers in 2024 were as follows:
