Dear Ms. Bridwell:

Louisville Gas and Electric Company (“LG&E”) and Kentucky Utilities Company (“KU”) (collectively, the “Companies”) submit this letter for inclusion in the record to note that the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) has already approved deviations for the Companies from the voltage survey and recordkeeping requirements contained in 807 KAR 5:041, Section 7.

As the Commission is aware, LG&E and KU sought deviations from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:041, Section 7 in their most recent base rate cases, Case No. 2025-00114 (LG&E) and Case No. 2025-00113 (KU), respectively. In the Commission’s February 16, 2026 Orders in those proceedings, the Commission expressly granted the Companies’ requests for deviation, subject only to any findings in this administrative proceeding.

Specifically, the Commission approved the Companies’ requests to satisfy the voltage survey and three year recordkeeping requirements of 807 KAR 5:041, Section 7 through the use of available Advanced Metering Infrastructure (“AMI”) data, rather than portable or recording voltmeters, and to be excused from the related maintenance and recordkeeping requirements applicable to voltmeters.

Nothing in the Commission’s orders in Case No. 2025-00131 alters, conditions, or otherwise reopens those approvals, which were issued expressly “subject to any findings” in this proceeding. The Companies submit this letter solely to ensure the record accurately reflects that procedural history and the Commission’s prior determinations.
