**RESPONSE TO COMMISSION STAFF REPORT  
AND MOTION TO DISMISS PROCEEDING**

McCreary County Water District (“McCreary District” or “the District”) submits its Response to the Commission Staff’s report and further moves for dismissal of this proceeding.

**Response to Commission Staff Report**

In its report, Commission Staff found that: (1) the District required Revenue From Sewer Rates of \$2,234,931; (2) the District’s existing rates for sewer service would produce annual revenues of \$2,242,595; and (3) no adjustment in the District’s rates for sewer service was required. While reserving its right to object in future proceedings to the appropriateness and reasonableness of specific adjustments proposed in the Commission Staff Report and to the application and use of specific methodologies, the District accepts for purposes of this proceeding Commission Staff’s findings regarding the District’s revenue requirement, revenue from sewer rates, and the need for an adjustment of the District’s rates for sewer service.

**Motion to Dismiss**

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 5, the District moves to dismiss this proceeding. At the Commission’s direction,<sup>1</sup> the District applied to adjust its rates for sewer service. Commission

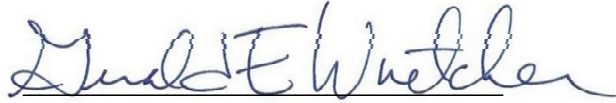

Staff having found that the District's existing rates are adequate to permit the District to furnish adequate, efficient and reasonable service, and the District having accepted those findings, no need for further proceedings in this matter exists and this matter should be dismissed.

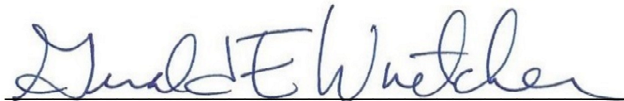
