Due to a rate increase from the Louisville Water Company, notice is hereby given that the North Nelson Water District has filed an application for a Purchased Water Adjustment with the Kentucky Public Service Commission for adjusting its water rates. Customer rates will increase by \$0.07 per 1,000 gallons used. The proposed change will be effective for service rendered on and after July 1, 2025.

The monthly bill for a residential customer using an average of 5,000 gallons per month will increase from \$32.63 to \$32.98. This is an increase of \$0.35 or 1.07%.

The City of Bardstown (Bardstown) is North Nelson Water District's only wholesale customer. Bardstown is contractually obligated to purchase a minimum of 3,000,000 gallons per month for the 2025 and 2026 calendar year. That is also its current average monthly usage. Bardstown's average monthly bill will increase from \$8,970.00 per month to \$9,180.00. This is an increase of \$210.00 per month or 2.34%.

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by North Nelson Water District. However, the Public Service Commission may order rates to be charged that differ from these proposed rates. Such action may result in rates for consumers other than the rates shown in this notice.
