807 KAR 5:110 does not speak directly to procedural steps for KRS 278.706(2)(h) and .714(2)(f). Historically, a copy of the email showing delivery to the county judge executive has met minimum statutory requirements for these statutes. To the extent that PSC regulation 807 KAR 5:001 speaks to Siting Board procedure, Application Exhibit F demonstrated proof of the date and manner of service of the papers on Judge Frank (including the authorized email address) and was sufficient to constitute compliance with the statutes. As Application Exhibit F provided with the Application demonstrates it was served upon Judge Frank on August 6, 2025, Exie respectfully requests that the Siting Board accept the Application as administratively complete as of August 6, 2025.
