A P P L I C A T I O N

This Application of the Lake Village Water Association, Inc., (the “Applicant”) of Boyle and Mercer Counties, Kentucky, respectfully shows:

1. That the Applicant is a non-profit water association of Boyle and Mercer Counties, Kentucky, created and existing under and by virtue of Chapter 273 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes. Applicant’s Articles of Incorporation were filed with the Secretary of State of Kentucky on May 2, 1968, and remains in good standing in the Commonwealth of Kentucky.


3. That the Applicant, pursuant to the provisions of KRS 278.020, seeks (i) a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, permitting the Applicant to perform maintenance on the bolts and seams of the Ison Lane Standpipe owned by the applicant; and (ii) approval of the use of a Cleaner Water Program grant to complete the project.


4. That the proposed construction project consists of power tool cleaning of the seams, a coating application and bolt replacement as necessary.
5. That the Applicant proposes to pay for the project with a Cleaner Water Program grant in the amount of \$72,589 and a local contribution from the Association in the amount of \$6,231.
6. That the Applicant proposes no change to the rates that are in effect.
7. That the Applicant does not contemplate having the Project completed with any deviation from minimum construction standards of the Public Service Commission.
8. That the Applicant files herewith the following Exhibits in support of this Application:
 - A. Currens Construction Services, LLC Bid (**Exhibit A**)
 - B. KIA Grant Assistance Agreement (**Exhibit B**)
9. That the foregoing constitutes the documents necessary to obtain the approval of the Commission in accordance with Section 278.020 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes.

WHEREFORE, the Applicant, the Lake Village Water Association, Inc., asks that the Public Service Commission of the Commonwealth of Kentucky grant to the Applicant, the following:

- a. A Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity permitting the Applicant to complete the necessary maintenance on the Ison Lane Standpipe.
- b. An Order approving the use of a Cleaner Water Program grant in the amount of \$72,589 and a local contribution of \$6,231 to complete the project .
