ORDERING PARAGRAPH 4 REPORT

By Order of September 9, 2025, the Commission approved the requested merger in this case. In that Order at Ordering Paragraph 4, the Commission directed the Joint Applicants to file a written status report of the transaction if it is not completed within six months after the Commission’s September 9, 2025 Order. Joint Applicant American Water Works Company, Inc. (“AWWC”) hereby provides notice that the transaction has not been completed and, therefore, submits this status report for the transaction.


AWWC filed Ordering Paragraph 7 reports on February 5, 2026 and February 25, 2026 in this matter indicating that approvals have been obtained from the respective regulatory commissions in Kentucky, Virginia, Tennessee, and Indiana. Those reports also indicated that approvals are still pending and have not been obtained in Illinois, Pennsylvania, Maryland, and New Jersey. Finally, those reports indicated that AWWC will notify this Commission when those approvals are obtained as required by Ordering Paragraph 7 of the Commission’s September 9, 2025 Order.

For the status of the pending Illinois approval, the parties submitted briefs on exceptions to the proposed order on February 26, 2026, and reply briefs are due March 10, 2026. The Illinois Commerce Commission has until April 30, 2026, to make its ruling in the matter.

For the status of the pending Pennsylvania approval, the parties are awaiting a Commission Order. For the status of the pending Maryland approval, the parties are awaiting a Commission Order. For the status of the pending New Jersey approval, a Public Comment Hearing was held on December 15, 2025 and the parties are awaiting a Commission Order. Pennsylvania, Maryland and New Jersey do not have statutory deadlines for a final decision. Once all approvals have been obtained, the transaction can be completed and closed.
