## MOTION FOR ADJUSTMENT OF PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Pursuant to KRS 278.700 et seq., and 807 KAR 5:110, Barrelhead Solar, LLC ("Barrelhead Solar"), by counsel, respectively submits this Motion requesting an adjustment of the procedural schedule in this matter.

On October 17, 2025, the Siting Board issued an Order establishing a procedural schedule "to ensure for the orderly processing of this proceeding." The sequencing of events and duration between deadlines contained in the procedural schedule is common to the processing of recent Siting Board cases. Currently, per the procedural schedule, the Siting Board shall file its supplemental requests for information to Barrelhead Solar no later than Monday, December 22, 2025, and Barrelhead Solar is instructed to file responses to these requests no later than Monday, January 5, 2026.

Barrelhead Solar seeks an order from the Siting Board amending the procedural schedule regarding the deadline for it to respond to the Siting Board's supplemental requests for information in light of the Christmas and New Year holidays. Currently, the Siting Board will issue its supplemental requests for information three days prior to Christmas, and Barrelhead Solar must respond the Monday after the New Year holiday. At present, multiple members of Barrelhead Solar and Birch Creek Development staff have planned paid time off during the week between the Christmas and New Year holidays. Additionally, Barrelhead Solar's consultant,

Copperhead Environmental Consulting, will be closed from December 24, 2025 to January 4, 2026. Barrelhead Solar respectfully requests the Siting Board amend the procedural schedule and allow it to respond to the supplemental request for information on Friday, January 9, 2026. This will allow Barrelhead Solar to respond to the Siting Board's requests without disrupting any preplanned paid time off for the holiday season.

Barrelhead Solar respects the Siting Board's, staff's, and consultant's need for sufficient time to review the supplemental responses. Accordingly, Barrelhead Solar additionally proposes the following procedural adjustments to allow sufficient time for both the Siting Board and the Siting Board's consultant to review the responses to supplemental requests for information:

Siting Board consultant's site assessment report shall be filed no later than
