- A 2-1a. The requested information is attached to this response as Attachment 2-1a.
- Item Number 2934. The C.I. Thornburg (Citco Water) invoice dated A 2-1b. January 22, 2024, (Invoice Number S100196403.002) in the amount of \$5,442.64, was for 27 new single port transceivers that Farmdale District ordered on September 15, 2022. There was an extraordinarily long wait time for these items to be shipped due to supply chain problems experienced by the manufacturer. These transceivers are the devices which are placed on customer water meters that enable remote reading of the meters. Since these transceivers were ordered, Farmdale District has entered into an agreement with the Frankfort Plant Board wherein Farmdale District purchases its transceivers through the Plant Board's contract with the supplier, thereby obtaining a discounted price on the devices. These 27 transceivers were ordered, received, and placed into use in Farmdale District's system before the agreement with the Frankfort Plant Board was in place. These items should be capitalized.

Item Number 2973. The C.I. Thornburg (Citco Water) invoice dated February 23, 2024, (Invoice Number S100247249.001) in the amount of \$3,427.24, was for 19 new 5/8 x 3/4-inch customer water meters. These

meters have been placed into service in Farmdale District's system, and they **should be capitalized**.

Item Number 3338. The Ferguson Waterworks invoice dated November 5, 2024 (Invoice Number 0300825) in the amount of \$5,789.27 was for 600 feet of 6-inch water line and necessary appurtenances to relocate a water line along Benson Creek. This should be capitalized.

Item Number 2977. The C & S Quality Services, LLC ("C & S") invoice dated March 7, 2024, (Invoice Number 24.02) in the amount of \$2,400, was for repairs made to Farmdale District's 500,000-gallon elevated storage tank known as the Stewart Home Tank. The Stewart Home Tank was inspected by Complete Restoration, LLC in February 2024 and found to be in need of emergency repairs. The bracing on the windage rods was loose and the bolts securing the interior ladder were seriously deteriorated. Windage rods resist the wind and stabilize elevated storage tanks against wind and seismic loads. Farmdale District contracted with C & S to make the necessary repairs. This expense should **not** be capitalized. It did not add to the useful life of the asset. This expense was for maintenance to return the asset to a safe and serviceable condition. More information concerning this repair is contained in Farmdale District's Response to Commission

Staff's First Post-Hearing Request for Information in Case No. 2022-00347.¹

Item Number 3300. The Gatewood Water Service ("Gatewood") invoice dated October 31, 2024, (Invoice Number 2024-10-FD) in the amount of \$4,465, was for contract labor and the use of an excavator, dump trailer, and backhoe to address leaks in Farmdale's system during the month of October 2024. Prior to entering into an Assistance Agreement and Mutual Aid Agreement with the Frankfort Plant Board, Farmdale District contracted with Gatewood Water Service when it had need of additional labor to address an emergency situation or when staffing levels were inadequate to meet the daily needs of the District. During the week of October 10, 2024, Farmdale District experienced an unusual number of leaks and requested assistance from Gatewood. Gatewood supplied one employee and equipment over a 7-day period. Farmdale District also requested Gatewood provide assistance to help fix a leak late in the evening on October 25, 2024. This leak was under the roadway. Once again on October 30, 2024, Farmdale District requested assistance with leak repair. This expense was for additional labor needed to efficiently address leaks in

the distribution system and should **not** be capitalized. The labor was not for the purpose of installing a capital asset, but for repairs to a capital asset. The repairs did not extend the life of the lines to which they were made. The repairs merely returned the lines to a serviceable condition.

Item Number 3096. The invoice dated June 17, 2024 from the Frankfort Plant Board in the amount of \$12,156 was for a 2014 Ford F250 truck. The truck is used in Farmdale District's daily operations, and it should be capitalized.

Item Number 3320. This entry dated November 25, 2024, in the amount of \$3,745.84 was for a number of items paid for using Farmdale District's credit card. All of these items are operating expenses and should not be capitalized. The individual invoices are included in Attachment 2-1a. The items are an oil change, tuition for a series of training classes offered by Kentucky Water Association, cleaning supplies, renewal of the software used to operate the District's GIS mapping system, a calculator, a boot cleaner, two cordless pumps used to pump water out of meter pits, a wrench, batteries and chargers for power tools, a pump used to pump mud from exposed lines, and the monthly fee paid to Intuit QuickBooks for payroll software. The software and support are renewed annually; therefore, they do not have value over more than a single accounting period and should be

expensed not capitalized. The pumps that were purchased are frequently replaced and cannot be predicted to last more than one year with regular use. Farmdale District uses both types of pumps regularly in repairing leaks and installing meters. Employee training costs are usually expensed using Generally Accepted Accounting Principles because employee training does not produce a definable asset with a useful life that the employer controls. All of these items are consumables used in daily operations, or in the case of the oil change, maintenance of a capital asset. They should be expensed, not capitalized.

Item Number 3256. This entry dated October 4, 2024, in the amount of \$3,200.86 was for a number of items paid for using Farmdale District's credit card. All of these items are operating expenses and **should not be capitalized**. The individual invoices are included in **Attachment 2-1a**. The items are computer virus protection software, renewal of the software and support used to operate the District's SCADA system, the monthly fee paid to Intuit QuickBooks for payroll software, gasoline for District equipment, and pizza for a District sponsored class instructing fire departments on the proper use of hydrants. The software and support are renewed annually; therefore, they do not have value over more than a single accounting period and should be expensed, not capitalized. All of the remaining items are

consumables used for legitimate operating purposes and should be expensed.

Attached to this response as **Attachment 2-1d** is the warranty information for the Sensus meters that Farmdale District used to arrive at its suggested useful life for the Sensus meters and transceivers.







The two auditor's adjustments listed below were made to take account #514 retirement from \$69,161.08 in the General Ledger to (\$14,627.55) in the audited Trial Balance. In file 2-2_Payroll_Worksheet_2024, the "Retirement" tab shows how the auditor calculated what account #514 should be, which is the employer portion of the retirement expense for each eligible employee, which came to \$27,957.45. Therefore, in journal entry #35, the auditor credited #514 retirement by \$41,203.63 to bring it from the original \$69,161.08 to their calculated \$27,957.45.

Then, because Farmdale District is part of Kentucky Public Pensions Authority ("KPPA"), the auditor was required to record the District's portion of the state retirement system's net pension liability, which is what journal entry #36 refers to. The net pension liability, deferred inflows of

resources, and deferred outflows of resources are determined by a chart provided by KPPA, and the difference (which in this case was a credit of \$42,585) is adjusted to account #514 pension expense, making that account now (\$14,627.55).

- Q 2-3. Refer to Item 1b. 2024 Trial Balance, Account 537 Contract Labor. Provide an explanation for the amount of \$13,268. Also, state why this account was not listed in the 2024 general ledger.
- A 2-3. The \$13,268 appearing in Account 537 Contract Labor in the 2024 Trial Balance consists of \$5,138.50 paid to a contract employee for assistance in obtaining the easements necessary for the AC line replacement project that is currently underway and \$8,130 paid to a contract employee to read customer meters. The contract employee who assisted with easements contacted customers, explained the need for the easement, witnessed and notarized the easement documents at the customer's residence and at their convenience. The contract employee who read the customer meters was employed to do so after the full-time employee who was responsible for meter reading quit. The contract employee was not a Farmdale employee but was familiar with the meter reading system used by Farmdale and was able to immediately step in to perform those duties temporarily. Farmdale District has now assigned meter reading to another full-time employee.

The \$8,130 in labor expense for the contract employee to read meters appears in the General Ledger Account Number 69800 Uncategorized Expenses. The total amount is divided into multiple entries under the memo titles of "Labor (meter reading)," "Labor/meter reading" and "Labor."

The \$5,138.50 for assistance in obtaining easements does not appear in the General Ledger because the account from which this expense was paid was new and had been opened, as required by Farmdale's lender, Rural Development, to pay the costs of the AC line replacement project. A copy of the cancelled check and a statement from the contract employee regarding receipt of payment is attached to this response as **Attachment 2-3**.

- Q 2-6. Refer to Farmdale District's response to Staff's First Request, Items 1-5e and 1-10a. Response 1-5e states that "[t]here were no overtime hours worked due to vacant positions that would be eliminated when the vacant positions are filled." Reconcile that response with the response to Iten 1-10a that approved overtime in May and July of 2025 for meter replacement and multiple staffing changes through 2024-2025. Quantify how much overtime is non-recurring vs. vacancy backfill.
- A 2-6. Because Farmdale District manually reads its purchase and zone meters daily, there will be overtime hours for doing this on weekends and holidays. Approximately 6 hours of overtime a week is due to the on-call field employee reading the purchase and zone meters on Saturday and Sunday. Farmdale also incurs overtime expenses when lines break after hours, or a leak repair cannot be accomplished within normal working hours. When a line break occurs during normal working hours Farmdale District continues repair operations until the leak is repaired. Likewise, if a leak occurs after hours, the Farmdale on-call employee will respond, assess the situation, and notify the Field Supervisor what help is required to fix the problem. The

Field Supervisor then contacts the number of employees necessary, and work begins immediately repair the line.

Filling vacant positions will mean fewer overtime hours paid to each employee who works on-call hours, but it will not eliminate the need for overtime expense to address after hours leaks and perform weekend and holiday reading of purchase and zone meters. Field employees rotate oncall responsibilities, so filling vacancies means each employee will work fewer overtime hours because the number of weeks per year that employee will be responsible for on-call duty will be reduced. However, the overall expense to Farmdale for on-call purchase and zone meter reading will remain the same. Farmdale District expects it will incur 342 hours of overtime expense each year to read its purchase and zone meters on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays. There is no accurate way for Farmdale District to predict the number of overtime hours that will be necessary to respond to line breaks.

Farmdale District did approve the use of overtime in the spring and summer of 2025 to meet the August 31, 2025 deadline for replacing all of its customer meters that were not in compliance with the meter-testing regulations. This was a unique situation brought about by the need to meet a deadline.

- A 2-9. Farmdale District obtains meter testing services from the Frankfort Plant Board ("FPB") and pays FPB's fee as specified in FPB's tariff for customer-requested meter tests. Attached to this response as **Attachment 2-9**, is the Cost Justification Sheet and the applicable page from FPB's tariff. Additionally, FPB's tariff can be viewed at: https://fpb.cc/fpb-tariff.

To calculate the transportation cost involved with the Meter Test Request, Farmdale District assumed traveling from Farmdale's office to its customer meter that is farthest from the FPB meter testing lab, transporting the meter to FPB, and returning the meter to the customer's residence. This encompasses 56.6 miles:

11 miles from Farmdale District's office to customer's residence;

17.3 miles from customer's residence to FPB;

17.3 miles back to customer's residence; and

11 miles back to Farmdale's office =

56.6 miles
