Note:  
 KU capital includes \$5.5m for the completion of a steel lattice tower on the Brown North to Alcalde transmission line (\$1.7m spent through March 2026 and \$3.8m projected through completion of the project in December 2026). During the May 16th storm, a portion of the Brown North-Alcalde (454017) and Pineville-West Garrard (454015) 345kV double circuit line and steel lattice towers sustained severe damage from an EF4 tornado – completely removing tower #249 from its foundation and damaging tower #250. Emergency installation of temporary structures was required to restore this portion of the bulk electric system by returning these lines back to service.
