The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Cecil made a motion to approve April minutes. Alfred seconded. All in favor.

Jeff Centers ask to be put on the agenda; however, he did not come to the meeting. He was concerned about April billing high due to a leak. The people that worked on his service line leak pulled the line loose from the valve. His was bill was \$896.40. The District's policy is to not make adjustments for leaks if it goes through the meter. No further action was taken.

In new business; Bath County Water has filed a purchased water adjustment of rates, effective July 15, 2025. The increase will be \$1.52 per thousand gallons. Judy make a motion to approve PWA, Billy seconded. All in favor.

The Bath County Fiscal Court reappointed Billy Martin, and Alfred Bailey to the board of commissioners. They will both need to be sworn in by June 29, 2025.

Ethan was given a copy of the invoice from Ferguson to replace meter at Pleasure Ridge Apartments. He will turn in to Ben, Gateway ADD, to draw funds from the Tank Rehab Project. Approximately \$1500.00 is left in contingency money. Ethan said this could be made to purchase tools that are needed.

Billy made a motion to adjourn. Judy seconded. All in favor.
