REQUEST:

Refer to Atmos's response to Commission Staff's First Request for Information, Item 5. Prepare and provide a cost-benefit analysis including a Total Resource Cost score for Atmos's DSM program.

RESPONSE:

See Attachment 1. The TRC score for the weatherization component is approximately 0.27. As noted in Staff 1-05 and in the Company's Order in Case No. 2017-00424, the Commission stated that "[it] recognizes that low-income weatherization programs provide valuable assistance to income-eligible customer by reducing their heating bills, and has consistently approved such programs despite unfavorable TRC scores." The Company has also kept relevant information intact within the tests from the Company's Case No. 2017-00424 filing to provide the Commission information on the rebate program in place at the time and for consideration as a follow up information per the Company's response in Staff 1-06.
