Nolin Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation Case No. 2025-00211 Commission Staff's Second Request for Information

Request 1: Refer to Nolin RECC's response to Commission Staff's First Request for Information, Item 10. In that response, Nolin RECC stated that it had identified a potential issue with the billing records used for lighting in Exhibit 4 and that the calculations for each row, including the application of the fuel adjustment clause (FAC) roll-in, warranted further review. Nolin RECC also indicated that it was closely examining this potential issue and would update the record in this case at the conclusion of its review.

- a. Provide an update on the status and results of this review.
- b. If the review has been completed, provide the revised lighting billing analysis in an Excel spreadsheet with cells unlocked, and identify all changes made.
- c. If the review has not been completed, explain the remaining steps.

Response 1(a)-(c): Nolin identified certain lights in the field that are not included in the current tariff; these lights are very similar to and/or are functionally equivalent to lighting options that are included in the current tariff. To address this, Nolin has moved those lights to the corresponding tariff light option in the pass-through rate model. The specific lighting options described herein are listed in the attached file, along with the resultant recategorized list, so all lights in the field are now counted in the pass-through model among the light options in the tariff.

The updated model also includes the revised pass-through allocation to Nolin from East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. ("Inc.")¹.
