

- a. Provide the billing analysis in Excel spreadsheet format with all formulas, rows, and columns unprotected and fully accessible.
- b. Reconcile Clark Energy's allocation of the East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. (EKPC) wholesale increase to the allocation assigned by EKPC to Clark Energy and explain any variance shown in Exhibit 4.

**Response 1(a): December 5, 2025 Update:**

On November 24, 2025, East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc., the Attorney General, and Nucor Steel Gallatin filed a Joint Stipulation, Settlement Agreement, and Recommendation in Case No. 2025-00208.<sup>1</sup> Based upon the filing in Case No. 2025-00208, Clark Energy is providing an updated Attachment 1-1.
