

## CUSTOMER NOTICE

The City of Dawson Springs Water and Sewer System is providing notice that it plans to file with the Public Service Commission, on or before August 15, 2025, to increase its wholesale water rate to the South Hopkins Water District effective for water service on and after August 15, 2025. The proposed rate is as follows:

South Hopkins Water District purchased 379,769,500 gallons of water from Dawson Springs during the Test Year (FYE June 30, 2025). Its average monthly purchases were 31,647,458 gallons. Under the current rate, South Hopkins Water District's average monthly bill is \$79,739.88. Under the proposed rate, South Hopkins Water District's average monthly bill will be \$102,625.23. This is an increase of \$22,885.35 per month or 28.7%.

Water flowing through the meters before the effective date will be charged at the current rate while water flowing through the meters on and after the effective date will be charged at the new rate.

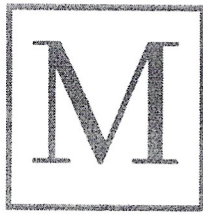
