## MOTION OF JOINT INTERVENORS APPALACHIAN CITIZENS' LAW CENTER, KENTUCKIANS FOR THE COMMONWEALTH, KENTUCKY SOLAR ENERGY SOCIETY, AND MOUNTAIN ASSOCIATION FOR LEAVE TO DEVIATE FROM RULE

Come now Appalachia Citizens' Law Center, Kentuckians for the Commonwealth, Kentucky Solar Energy Society, and Mountain Association (collectively "Joint Intervenors"), by and through counsel, and move for leave to deviate from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:001 Section 8. In support of their motion Joint Intervenors state as follows:

- 1. 807 KAR 5:001 Section 8(3) requires filings be made with the Commission via the Commission's E-Filing System at <a href="http://psc.ky.gov">http://psc.ky.gov</a>. 807 KAR 5:001 Section 8(4) requires electronic filings be made in one of several set formats. 807 KAR 5:001 Section 8(6) sets limits on the size of electronic filings. 807 KAR 5:001 Section 22 allows deviation from the rules in special cases upon good cause shown.
- 2. The Joint Intervenors are timely filing their Responses to Commission
  Staff's Joint Data Requests on December 08, 2025. One of the workpapers responsive
  to a Staff Request in Excel format exceeded the size limitation of 807 KAR 5:001

Section 8(6), and the Commission's E-Filing System. A copy of that workpaper is being provided via link to <a href="mailto:psced@ky.gov">psced@ky.gov</a>, and counsel for all Parties. A thumb drive version is also being sent via US mail.

Wherefore, Joint Intervenors respectfully request the Commission grant the leave requested, and grant leave to deviate from the rule requiring all filings be made via the Commission's E-Filing System.
