Kentucky Power Company’s Notice Regarding Data Requests From Non-Parties

Kentucky Power Company (“Kentucky Power” or the “Company”) hereby respectfully provides notice to the Commission and the parties that the Joint Movants (Appalachian Citizens’ Law Center, Kentuckians for the Commonwealth, Kentucky Solar Energy Society, and Mountain Association), Kentucky Solar Industries Association, Inc., and SWVA Kentucky, LLC have not yet been granted leave to intervene in this proceeding, and that to the extent they are granted intervention, Kentucky Power Company will file responses to the data requests propounded by each of those entities by the end of the business day following the date of the Commission’s order granting their respective motions for leave to intervene.¹

¹ 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(12)(d) requires responses to be filed to data requests issued by “parties.” Persons requesting leave to intervene are not considered parties until their intervention is granted. See 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(11).
