**Kentucky Power Company’s Motion For Informal Conference**

Kentucky Power Company (“Kentucky Power” or “Company”) moves the Public Service Commission of Kentucky (“Commission”) pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(4) to convene an in-person informal conference during the week of March 23, 2026, or the week of March 30, 2026. The purpose of the informal conference is to discuss the issues presented in Kentucky Power’s March 20, 2026 Motion for Rehearing, as well as to provide Commission Staff any information that may aid in the handling and disposition of the Motion for Rehearing and/or rehearing process. The undersigned counsel will work with Commission Staff to aid in the scheduling of the time of the requested informal conference if the proposed date or time is not available.

The Motion for Rehearing requests, among other things, that the Commission grant immediate rehearing relief in the form of an order allowing the Company to defer the vegetation management capital investments made from June 1, 2025, through March 1, 2026, for future review and recovery in the Company’s next base rate case. The Motion respectfully requests that such relief be ordered by **no later than Monday, April 6, 2026**, so it can be reflected in Kentucky Power’s first quarter 2026 financial statements. This would allow Kentucky Power to avoid a

potential \$17 million write-off that will have significant impacts on the Company's financial metrics. Additional information on this request is provided in the Motion for Rehearing.<sup>1</sup>

Kentucky Power therefore respectfully requests that the informal conference be scheduled prior to April 6, 2026, so that, if necessary, Kentucky Power can provide any information required to grant the immediate relief requested, while the rehearing process on the Company's other identified issues progresses on a normal rehearing schedule.

WHEREFORE, Kentucky Power respectfully requests the Commission convene an in-person informal conference at the Public Service Commission, 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, KY 40601, during the week of March 23, 2026, or the week of March 30, 2026.
