**Kentucky Power Company’s Statement Regarding
Hearing and Motion for Briefing Deadline**

Kentucky Power Company (“Kentucky Power” or “Company”) respectfully requests that this matter be submitted for decision on the record. In support of its request, Kentucky Power states as follows:

The Commission granted in part, and denied in part, Kentucky Power’s Motion for Rehearing of its February 28, 2026, Order on April 9, 2026 (the “Rehearing Order”). The Rehearing Order contained a brief procedural schedule. Commission Staff and Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers (“KIUC”) issued their first set of rehearing data requests on April 24, 2026. Kentucky Power filed responses to these data requests on May 8, 2026. Commission Staff issued its second set of rehearing data requests on May 21, 2026, to which the Company responded on June 5, 2026. The other intervening parties, the Office of the Attorney General, Kentucky Solar Energy Industries Association, Inc., SWVA Kentucky, LLC, and Appalachian Citizens’ Law Center, Kentuckians for the Commonwealth, Kentucky Solar Energy Society, and Mountain Association (collectively “Joint Intervenors”), did not issue any rehearing data requests.

In light of the limited participation by the intervening parties and the thoroughness of the data requests from Commission Staff, the record on rehearing in this case has been sufficiently

developed and, therefore, Kentucky Power respectfully requests that this matter be submitted for decision on the record after the parties are provided an opportunity to submit one round of briefs on the issues presented on rehearing. Kentucky Power respectfully requests that the Commission establish June 26, 2026, as the deadline for the simultaneous submission of briefs addressing the issues on rehearing, with the case then submitted for a decision on the written record as of 11:59 p.m. on that date.
