**RESPONSE TO KENTUCKY POWER’S MOTION TO RECESS**

On January 9, 2026, Kentucky Power Company (“Kentucky Power”) filed a Motion to Recess Hearing to give the Commission additional time to review the proposed Settlement Agreement and related documents. The Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, through his Office of Rate Intervention (“AG”), provides the following response to that Motion.

The Proposed Settlement Agreement represents a settlement of the issues between Kentucky Power, the Kentucky Industrial Utilities Customers (“KIUC”), and the Kentucky Solar Energy Industries Association only. The AG, the Appalachian Citizens’ Law Center, Kentuckians for the Commonwealth, the Mountain Association, and SWVA Kentucky, LLC did not join the Settlement Agreement.

Importantly, Kentucky Power’s Motion stated, “Kentucky Power, the other parties to this case, and Commission Staff began participating in settlement discussions in December 2025.” To be clear, the AG did not participate in settlement discussions in this

matter. While invited to the initial settlement meeting, the Attorney General declined to participate in those discussions viewing settlement of this matter as inappropriate.

The Attorney General is prepared to proceed with the hearing in this matter according to the schedule the Commission deems appropriate.


