The Garrard County Water Association requests that the Commission allow for an adjustment to our rates in accordance with 807 KAR 5:068 Purchased Water Adjustment. The District was notified by its supplier, City of Lancaster, that their wholesale rates will increase effective August 1, 2025. The result of the increase in purchased water expense is \$147,041.85 in supply cost to the District. This translates into an increase of \$0.40 per 1,000 gallons of water sold to our customers.
