Source and nature of this exhibit. The passage below is a transcription of the Kentucky State Board on Electric Generation and Transmission Siting's public video record of the June 10, 2026 evidentiary hearing in Case No. 2025-00395, from approximately 1:55:19 to 1:58:43 of the hearing video (timestamps shown in brackets as h:mm:ss of elapsed video time). The transcription is machine-generated and is provided as an aid to locating the cited testimony; the hearing video itself is the authoritative record, and the Board is respectfully referred to it at the timestamps indicated.

[1:55:19] Okay. And that this is a different developer than that case. Correct. Correct.

[1:55:23] Okay. Um, in the materials that he was asking about in the Crab Run case, is it My

[1:55:32] understanding, and please correct me if I'm wrong, but let me know if this is correct. My understanding is that that what he was referring to was a

[1:55:39] preliminary draft of a template that you had prepared and was accidentally left in the record in the Crab Run case. Is that correct?

[1:55:48] That is correct. And I identified it as such in the Crab Run hearing. I identified that that was left in inadvertently as part of the original template.

[1:56:41] Okay. And so it seemed like maybe the public commenter um thought that something that belonged in that case or belonged in this case was filed in the wrong case. Is that what happened?

[1:57:00] creating the template. It helps me to use realw world examples to I can make sure that the data actually applies as opposed to putting in blanks and so I use real world examples.

[1:58:03] did whenever I did do that, it would be listed in here. Um, again, we reached out to every assessor

[1:58:10] in Kentucky. I did not get a response from Graves County, so I do not have any information from them.
